RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PROCESS

- Contact the Klamath County Planning Dept. to verify zoning and determine if a dwelling is permitted on the property.
- Obtain a Land Use Compatibility Statement (LUCS) from the Planning Dept. for a septic evaluation.
 - Provide proof of Legal Access; if your property does not front a public road, provide a copy of all recorded easements to a public right-of-way.
 - Submit a site plan of the property, indicating where the proposed test holes will be located and where the home is intended to be placed.
 - The fee is \$29
- 3. Obtain a septic evaluation approval from the Klamath County On-Site/Septic Dept.
 - Contact the On-Site/Septic Dept. for requirements and fee.
- 4. Obtain a LUCS from the Planning Dept. for a septic system installation.
 - Submit a site plan of the property, indicating the proposed location of the septic tank and location and layout design of the initial and replacement drain fields.
 - The fee is \$29
- Obtain a septic system installation permit from the Klamath County On-Site/Septic Dept.
 - · Contact the On-Site/Septic Dept. for requirements and fee.
- Obtain a LUCS from the Planning Dept. for a home site approval.
 - Submit a site plan showing where the home will be located on the property including distance to property lines.
 - The fee is \$87 -
- Obtain a sign-off on the LUCS from the On-Site Dept. verifying that the location of the home will not interfere with the septic system.
- 8. Obtain an address from Public Works Department.
- 9. Obtain required building permits from the Building Dept.
 - > A building permit for a "dwelling," has to be issued and remain active in order to have any accessory structures.
 - > A dwelling can either be stick-built or a manufactured home.
